BEHIND-THE-WHEEL PROFICIENCY CONCERN

1. Teen student was unable to meet behind-the-wheel proficiency standards of Life Driving Academy during the Segment 1 course.
2. Student would be considered unsafe to drive with others that are not certified by the State of Michigan as a certified instructor with a vehicle equipped for driver's education.

RECOMMENDATIONS

1. Recommend a minimum of 6 additional hours in the form of private drives with a State of Michigan certified driver's education instructor.
2. Recommend working on all areas that the student was non-proficient in during the Segment 1 class as well as any other growth areas.
3. Do not recommend parents or others to drive with the student until student can show proficiency and are deemed safe by a State of Michigan driver's education provider.
